Punkt 4: MA-reform process - visit from the GDS work group

Nomination:

The study board has invited the working group for the new GDS programme to talk about the process and cooperation between the study board and the working group.

Beslutning

The Chair gave a brief introduction to Louise Wiuff Moe, who represented the writing group for the new GDS programme and gave an overview of the broader process which was introduced on the MA-reform kickoff meeting 28th of April.

GDS will have to change name however the programme itself will not have to be fully changed as opposed to some of the programmes which was in "rul 1" in the fall.

The GDS process is divided into two phases, first is the scope of the programme and second phase is the study regulations.

The study board emphasised that it is important for the writing group to create a identity between the education and the jobmarket. The study board expressed concern about the combination of the current GDS and IPG and wants both of them to be well represented in the new programme.

The secretary informed about the process in the E25 for the business studies and how the GDS group can hopefully draw on some of those experiences.

Educational coordinator Kristian Zornig Svenstrup will be the primary TAP support for the GDS working group.

The study board thanked Louise for her participation.

 - Examination and assessment criteria (implemented) – only MA-level activities
- In particular checks:
 - That the content of the fields is in accordance with changes to study regulations decided in the fall, e.g., if the content of “Detailed description” or “Examination and assessment criteria (implemented)” is updated if the exam form was changed in the fall.
 - If the field “Examination and assessment criteria (implemented)” – only MA-level activities – is properly filled in.
 - “Properly”, meaning that the information that was taken out of the MA-study regulations with the 2022 “framework” study regulations (rammestudieordninger) is now stated here, see appendices 3-5 (were sent to all course convenors prior to the period where they can edit their activities).
 - “Properly” also meaning that the activity has assessment criteria – preferably with intro and outro: “It is evaluated to which degree the student show ability to [bullets] and if the formal criteria to the [written product] are fulfilled”.
