Beslutning

It's custom to evaluate all the basic courses, so it's really a question of which elective course we want to have evaluated. That we've usually done all of them.

Klaas: Wonders if we might be over evaluating and thus contributing to the evaluation fatigue.

Helene: The elective basic courses are most often taken by Humbach students. Helene would love to put them together, however, there are some structural issues, which means that they need to be separate courses, and being taught at different times by different teachers, apart for sociology, which is basically copy/paste. In regard to fatigue, the important thing is the process of doing the evaluation. More focus on how the course leaders engage in the evaluations and use it constructively, instead of just having the study board looking at it would no doubt benefit the whole process.

Mihaela: There are a lot of evaluations, and it gets quite confusing. Maybe lower the amount of the surveys and have the teachers ask the student for oral feedback. In that way, we could do half of the course evaluation each other year.

Lars: It's a good idea not to do all of them. It is important for the students to feel more ownership of the evaluations. Maybe there's a need for a discussion with the teachers figure out how to do it in practice. The evaluations might benefit from being scheduled with an important lecture, and also having the feedback to be visible during the evaluations process, for the students to develop more ownership.

Helene: Would like the the Study Boards mandate to work with the course responsible together with Andres who is specifically sitting with the evaluations and feedback processes. (everyone agrees to this).

Klaas: Would like to have a follow-up discussion on the evaluation practice later this semester.

Helene: Will be October/November.
