Beslutning

The board discussed the number of advanced study courses held at GDS

The board would like to limit to three courses in F23, due to the risk of cancelled courses and educators' resources used in the planning courses that end up being cancelled.

The board decided to cancel Global justice and advocacy in F23, due to the lack of prior educators on the course having resources to run and hand over the course to the new course responsible.

Punkt 4: Number of elective courses GDS IPG

The board are asked to discuss some guidelines for number of elective courses offered at our different educations from E23-F25.

Beslutning

The board had a general discussion regarding the number of elective courses - a suggestion where raised regarding that the number of students will decide the number of elective courses held.

Klaas have a comment regarding that courses should not necessary be open to many other programs, due to that their prerequisite for participating in the course could vary a lot.

The board would like to encourage study leaders to investigate courses from other programmes when designing their own elective courses

Regarding the number of elective courses pr program, the board would like to be able to take a decision based on the number of student enrolled on the specific program each semester.

A rule of thumb could be that it requires 25 students to offer a elective course, due to the minimum of participants to be able to run the course, and the number of elective courses is decided by taking the cohort of students and divide them in courses of min 25 students

Communication to students regarding elective courses that are cannceled, should be improved. The board would like to place the responsible for communicating this, at the head of studies.
