Punkt 6: Final course offer E22

There are two decisions to be made under this item:

1. Decision about shutting down courses due to lack of registrations.

2. Decision about offering the project Current Issues in E22.

It is suggested that the study board offers the project Current Issues in E22.

This is due to the fact, that many students who started on 1 February are not aware that they are supposed to do their 3. semester in the fall. Many students want to do an internship in their 3. semester but by now the students do not have the time to make the necessary preparations for doing an internship in the autumn semester. In order to make it possible for them to have an internship in the spring of 2023 instead, they need to do courses and a 15 ECTS project in E22. This requires a change of the transmission rules as described in the appendix GS-1-fags_overgangsregler 2 semester.

Beslutning

Concerning course offer: No courses were shut down. The courses with too few students are all mandatory 1. semester courses.

Concerning offering the project Current Issue: SB recommends the suggested solution about offering the project Current Issues in E22. The SB decided that Helle writes to Bodil that the SB has made this choice but asks Bodil for funding. According to Klaas Dykmann it is a relatively small group of students that are concerned.

Punkt 7: Distribution of grades

The secretary has decided that I would not be able to create graphs and historical data on grade statistics, therefore the board would need to act on the appendix in the following form.

Beslutning

The SB discussed the distribution of grades for the winter exam 2021. The first comment was that there is too few students in the material to make any conclusions.

It was noted that the discussion was carried through on a poor basis and that the SB missed the Power BI material that is normally produced for this item on the agenda. E.g., the SB normally can compare years. Helle informed that next semester things should be back to normal.

Other comments:

- It was suggested that - for the comparison - the data includes the exam form.
- Two grades or more difference between some of the courses. This is within the range of what it has been other years.
- There should be less dispersion

It was decided to send the spread sheet to the teachers as basis for discussion in the teaching groups. It might be helpful to reflect on both teaching and exams and to see colleagues' courses as it could be inspiring to see the data for others. Maybe it could create reflections like "Is the question too easy?" e.g.

Helle sends an e-mail with the spread sheet to the course convenors - just for information - but only for exams having more than 5 students. The e-mail should also inform that the data basis is poor this semester and that we will be back on BI-track next semester.
