Beslutning

The study board found these news very positive that all students have a legal claim and that the intake procedure is essentially back to normal from 2027. From 2028 it will be the new MA-programme students can apply to. The IPG programme will also have legal claim for intake 2026 and 2027. As the number of students is estimated to be very low for 2026 the study start will be joint for GDS and IPG.
