IS students that are SAB students had to ask for permission to write in English. A bit confusing, but the students were satisfied.

Beslutning

Helene gave an oral orientation of the Open Day: Lots of people present asking questions. It seems that many of them want to do their BA at RUC but their MA at KU. Possible reason: the admission requirements are easier to meet at RUC. But it is also reputation and, eventually, employability. Quite a few second semester students attended to use the open day as a possibility to talk to staff about choice of subject module. The present second semester students need more information about the new degrees -

Klaas: The Bologna spirit only works in the direction away from RUC - not the direction to RUC. This is not related to quality - the applicants decide before they start their bachelor.

Sofie: informal subject module day - the official one is fine but more is needed. Organised by Studenterrådet.

How do we promote our MA programmes internally?

Action: Helene takes these two issues of subject selection day & internal promotion of MA programmes up with the Vice Dean.

Beslutning

Helene informed the study board that we have the first case of exam cheating in a course where the student has used ChatbotGPT.

The course leader found out because the text was "cold", "metallic". Also, it had subheadings that did not connect. ChatGPT basically creates its own references and make up journals. It took quite some time for the course leader to detect the fraud.

Helene cooperated with the legal department who adviced to treat the matter as exam cheat. The case is now at the legal department.

the study board discussed the case and raised several issues:

We have to include ChatbotGPT in the teaching - to be critical towards it. Since it is already there we should have an action plan?

Guidelines: ChatbotGPT is cheating.

Can we on a long term have tools to detect the use of ChatGPT - like Urkund?

It will be used all over - we have to decide how it can be used in a pedagogical way.

Can teachers get a description of what to look for to detect cheat? Not at the moment - but Helene will invite for a lunch meeting for all teachers.

Advice to examinor: ask ChatGPT yourself to get an impression of how your exam question is answered.

Helene: it is primarily the weaker, struggling students who are tempted to use it.

Remember, that it is not only about ChatGPT - other things are available out there.
